We have spent some time getting back into our house which had been closed up while we were on furlough and readjusting to life in Kenya: power outages; water rationing; dust so thick you can taste it; and geckos darting out from behind hand towels, curtains, or picture frames when least expected. It certainly is good to be back home!

We have also been getting settled back into the ministry here. I have had the opportunity to preach in two of our churches, at Thindigua and at Tena Estate, and will soon be preaching at the church in Ruaka. I have also had the opportunity to speak with all of our pastors to see how the works are doing. It is a blessing to see that all are continuing to serve the Lord and to reach into their communities with the Gospel with a vision to do even more.

In addition, we are making preparations to resume classes in the Institute. After the troubles following the last elections, I have decided to wait until after the upcoming elections in March to start classes. Please pray for Kenya that these elections will be fair and trouble free.

A Word of Praise

I want to close with a word of praise to God. Our grandson Kacey, who was born with life-threatening heart problems, is now 1 ½ years old and has been released by the doctors from all physical therapy. He is a typical toddler: running all over the place, getting into trouble, and gibber-jabbering up a storm. Kacey truly is a Miracle Baby, and we thank God for all He has done in answer to the prayers of so many of you.

I also want to thank the Lord for the safety He has given, both in our travels in the States and in our return to Kenya. We traveled approximately 50,000 miles, in addition to the travel from Kenya and back, without any major breakdowns or accidents. We flew back to Kenya with nine pieces of checked luggage, and it all arrived on the flight with us and intact. God has proven His goodness to us many times, and we thank Him for His great love and mercy and for the privilege of serving Him and of representing you in Kenya.
